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## Successful Learning – Responsible Living

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Dear Parent/Guardian,

Morrisset High School will be conducting the annual school swimming carnival on Friday the 1<sup>st</sup> of February 2019. The carnival will be held at Speers Point Swimming Pool. The swimming carnival is a compulsory school event.

The cost of entry to the swimming carnival is \$3.50 per student. The carnival will commence at 8.30am for all students wanting to compete in all 200m and medley events. These students will need to make their own way to the venue to arrive in time for the events.

The school has organised buses to transport students from Morrisset High School to the pool. The buses will depart Morrisset High School at 8.45am and will arrive at **Speers Point Pool** at 9.15am for roll call. Students taking the bus to the pool will need to pay **\$10.00** when they get on the bus which includes their pool entry fee.

At the conclusion of the carnival students will be dismissed from the venue at 2.00pm. Those students who will be travelling via normal school buses will be transported back to school via the buses provided in time for normal afternoon bus.

Students will not be given permission to leave the carnival earlier unless they are accompanied by their parent or guardian.

Students attending the day must bring back the below permission slip below to the PE staffroom ASAP.

*If there are any changes due to weather etc, then this information will be communicated through our SkoolBag app (see reverse for details on how to get this app).*
