HOW DO STUDENTS JOIN EXCELLERATE?

Expressions of interest for Excellerate 2026 are open. Families complete an online application form, and applicants complete Cognitive Abilities testing at Morisset High School (on Tuesday, May 13, 2025). The results of the testing, as well as feedback from the applicant's primary teachers are used to assess a student's potential to thrive in this unique learning program.

- Strong academic performance across a range of subjects.
