HSC Masterclasses

To help you prepare for your exams our Year 12 teachers have prepared targeted Masterclasses, used past HSC exams and Trial HSC exam papers, to be held next week (Week 9) and Week 10 – from Monday, September 6 to Friday, September 17, 2021. There will be no Masterclasses on Friday, September 10, 2021 as the whole school takes a pause and focuses on wellbeing for R U Ok Day.

The Masterclasses are not assessable, but will be an excellent opportunity for teachers and our Year 12 students to share knowledge and touch base.

What are Masterclasses?

- Year 12 course teachers will be conducting Masterclasses focused on unpacking past HSC exam papers and exam preparation.
- Teachers will share their 'tips and tricks' in successfully navigating and competing HSC exams.

When will this happen and how will it be delivered?

- Teachers will communicate with students via Google Classrooms and email as to when Masterclasses will be conducted during Week 9 and 10.
- Teachers will make available copies of past HSC questions and papers.

Do I have to do it?

- Masterclasses are not assessable, however, are the best way to prepare students for their HSC exams in Term 4.
- Teachers will be expecting high student engagement because they want all their students to do well and be the best they can be.

Due to the nature of the course and final assessments, the following classes will not have a Masterclass:

- SLR
- Work Studies
- Mathematics Standard 1
